East Stroudsburg University invites applications for a full-time, tenure track position beginning Fall 2007. Positions typically fill at the Assistant Professor rank. A doctorate in sport management or related field is preferred. ABD candidates are encouraged to apply but should make clear what progress they have made on their dissertation. Minimum of three years (preferably college), undergraduate and graduate teaching experience; internship experience in sport management and evidence of scholarly activity are required. Active membership in NASSM and/or NASPE (preferred). Ability to incorporate the use of technology in teaching and experience working with diverse populations is preferred. The successful candidate will be expected to teach courses and advise in the undergraduate and graduate sport management programs, preferred expertise in the area of sport personnel and computer applications in sport management. Service and scholarship are expected. The successful candidate will provide leadership in expanding and strengthening the offerings in the sport personnel area of study; supervise internships; engage in scholarly activity; and provide service to the department, university, and community. Final determination will be based upon a successful interview, which will include a teaching demonstration. All candidates must furnish proof of eligibility to work in the U.S. and official transcripts at time of employment.
