Sport Management Department

Available: Flagler College invites applications for a full-time faculty position in the Sport Management Department, beginning in January **OR** August, 2007

College and Area Flagler College was built as a hotel in 1888 and was founded as a college in 1968. It is a private, coeducational college with an enrollment of over 2,000 students. The role of teaching is central to the college's mission. The College is located in the small coastal community of St. Augustine, approximately 35 miles south of Jacksonville and 55 miles north of Daytona Beach. The campus lies in the heart of the historic district in the nation's oldest city. St. Augustine has an ideal climate, historic landmarks (including Flagler College), magnificent beaches and an Old World ambiance which provides an inviting campus environment for an institution of higher education.

Essential Qualifications: Earned doctorate in Sport Management; or if in a closely related field, **must** include 18 graduate hours in Sport Management. Will consider ABD if the degree is awarded **before** April 15, 2007. Commitment to teaching undergraduate students in sport management is the primary responsibility. **Evidence of a strong teaching background and experience at the college level is absolutely essential.** Teaching experience is required in the areas of **sport finance, sport marketing, sport entrepreneurship** and introduction to sport management. The candidate will be responsible for academic advising, directing internships and apprenticeships and serving on college wide committees. The candidate will have experience in the sport industry and a strong public speaking background

Preferred Qualifications: The preferred candidate will have experience in organizing community or college events and conferences or symposiums. He/she will also have a background in curriculum development, student club advising and fundraising. The ideal candidate will have a **passion for teaching** and working with students in and out of the classroom.

Rank & Salary: Assistant Professor, Rank and Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Department: The Sport Management Department offers a BA in Sport Management. It was the very first undergraduate program to be approved by SPMRC in the state of Florida. Approximately 150 undergraduate students are enrolled in the Sport Management program. There are currently two full time faculty and numerous adjunct instructors. The required curriculum includes 59 hours of sport management classes and 15 hours in the business core. Providing practical application of classroom theory is expected of the faculty. Two major community events are coordinated by the students each year.

Application: Applicants should send a letter of application, curriculum vitae, unofficial graduate degree transcripts, evidence of teaching effectiveness, and three references (names, addresses, and telephone numbers) to Paula B.
